

Students with Disabilities – Services and Facilities

The Yeshiva welcomes students with disabilities. The Yeshiva is committed to meeting disabled students' needs and will work with the student and his family to facilitate his study at the Yeshiva.

The Yeshiva's Disability Services Coordinator is Avrohom Dovid Feuer. He may be reached at (732) 367-1060, extension 4273. Upon request, he will arrange for a senior level administrator with experience arranging for disabled students' needs to meet with a prospective or enrolled student to evaluate what needs he has and how the school can best meet these needs. As necessary, the Yeshiva will arrange for accommodations in dormitories to accommodate mobility impairment and other challenges facing disabled students.

The Yeshiva does not currently offer a comprehensive transition and postsecondary program for students with intellectual disabilities.
